**Matthew 25** Preparation, wisdom & grace to carry the anointing.

**Mark 10:29-30** Preparing for the blessing and promises of God  
**AND Prepare for the persecution**

.....we know that's God taking us where we can't go on our own. But here's the key: the blessing doesn't come by itself. Jesus told his disciples in **Mark chapter 10:29-30**, "Anything you give up for my sake: houses, property, people, you will receive in this life a hundredfold return **with persecution**"

**29** And Jesus answered and said, Verily I say unto you, There is no man that hath left house, or brethren, or sisters, or father, or mother, or wife, or children, or lands, for my sake, and the gospel's,

**30** But he shall receive an hundredfold now in this time, houses, and brethren, and sisters, and mothers, and children, and lands, **with persecutions**; and in the world to come eternal life.

**Exodus 25:8** Preparation for the work of ministry. Creating a habitation for the presence of God.

**1 Corinthians 3:16-17** That your body would be prepared as a sanctuary for God

**Proverbs 16:3** “Commit your work to the LORD, and your plans will be established.”

....This verse highlights the significance of entrusting our plans and preparations to God. When we commit our work to the Lord, seeking His guidance and direction, our plans are more likely to succeed. God’s wisdom and providence can shape our preparations and ensure that they align with His purposes

**Proverbs 24:27** “Prepare your work outside; get everything ready for yourself in the field, and after that build your house.”

.....This verse encourages prioritizing preparations and establishing a solid foundation before moving on to other endeavors. Just as a farmer must prepare their field before building their house, it is wise for us to lay the groundwork, complete necessary tasks, and develop a strong foundation before undertaking new projects or commitments.
