2023 The Year of Expansion, Fruitfulness and Acceleration.

Isaiah 54:1-3, Amos 9:13, Joel 2:23

FOCUS: Keep the Fire Burning

WORD: As we approach the end of this fast, you are probably sensing that over the last few weeks God has begun uniquely moving in your heart and in your life. Fasting has a way of quieting our hearts so that God can start to work in the situations we have been praying for and draws us close to him.

Leviticus 6:9 gives us a clear picture of God's presence in our lives. God had descended on the Tent of Meeting and **kindled a fire**. God's instructions to his people were to **keep the fire burning**. God told Moses: "Give Aaron and his sons this command: 'These are the regulations for the burnt offering: The burnt offering is to remain on the altar throughout the night, till morning, and the fire must be kept burning on the altar.

God would say that every day a burnt offering would be offered in the morning at 9:00 a.m. and in the evening at 3:00 p.m. This is our a reminder that TOTAL devotion to God was to be continual and ongoing. . It's a symbol of the commitment of the true worshiper. ***Nothing would be left of the sacrifice; it would have been totally consumed on the altar in the presence of the Lord.***

God has started a fire inside of us through this fast, and it is our responsibility to keep what God has sparked in each of us burning. That will require **total devotion** to him because it is spiritually deadly to stop what God has started in you.

This fast has given us the opportunity to give up certain things to seek God on a deeper level. While our seeking God may look different after this fast is over, the commitment and intentionality of spending time with him should remain the same.

Regardless of the days, God will honor your sacrifice and bless you in return
The Lord has started a powerful work in your life; **keep the fire burning**

It is our prayer that fasting will become a lifestyle. As a Church we are committed to fasting once a month corporately. Join us!

PROPHETICALLY SPEAKING:

With God, we are to never let the fire on the altar of our hearts burn out. I decree that we burn with His passion, His prayers, His ways. His praise is to continually be in our mouth. I declare that we pray without ceasing and that you NEVER grow weary in well doing.

Remember you ave the Sprit of God in you and he is watching over his word to perform it in your lives. At times it seems easier to walk away than to press in prayer for the breakthrough. "May the fire on your altar never burn out." Yes there will be times where It would be easier to not show love to that angry co-worker or family member. Be I speak over your lives that "The fire on the altar never burn out." It would be great to right off that friend that betrayed us instead of forgive. 'May the fire on the altar never burn out.'" It may seem better to eat rather than fast continually. "May the fire on my altar never burn out." WHY? Because God is worth it all!

SCRIPTURES:

Leviticus 6:9 "Give Aaron and his sons this command: 'These are the regulations for the burnt offering: The burnt offering is to remain on the altar hearth throughout the night, till morning, **and the fire must be kept burning on the altar.**'"

Leviticus 6:13 The fire must be kept burning on the altar continuously; it must not go out.

Galatians 6:9 And let us not be weary in well doing: for in due season we shall reap, if we faint not.

Psalms 34: 1-8 I will bless the Lord at all times: his praise shall continually be in my mouth.

2 My soul shall make her boast in the Lord: the humble shall hear thereof, and be glad.

3 O magnify the Lord with me, and let us exalt his name together.

4 I sought the Lord, and he heard me, and delivered me from all my fears.

5 They looked unto him, and were lightened: and their faces were not ashamed.
